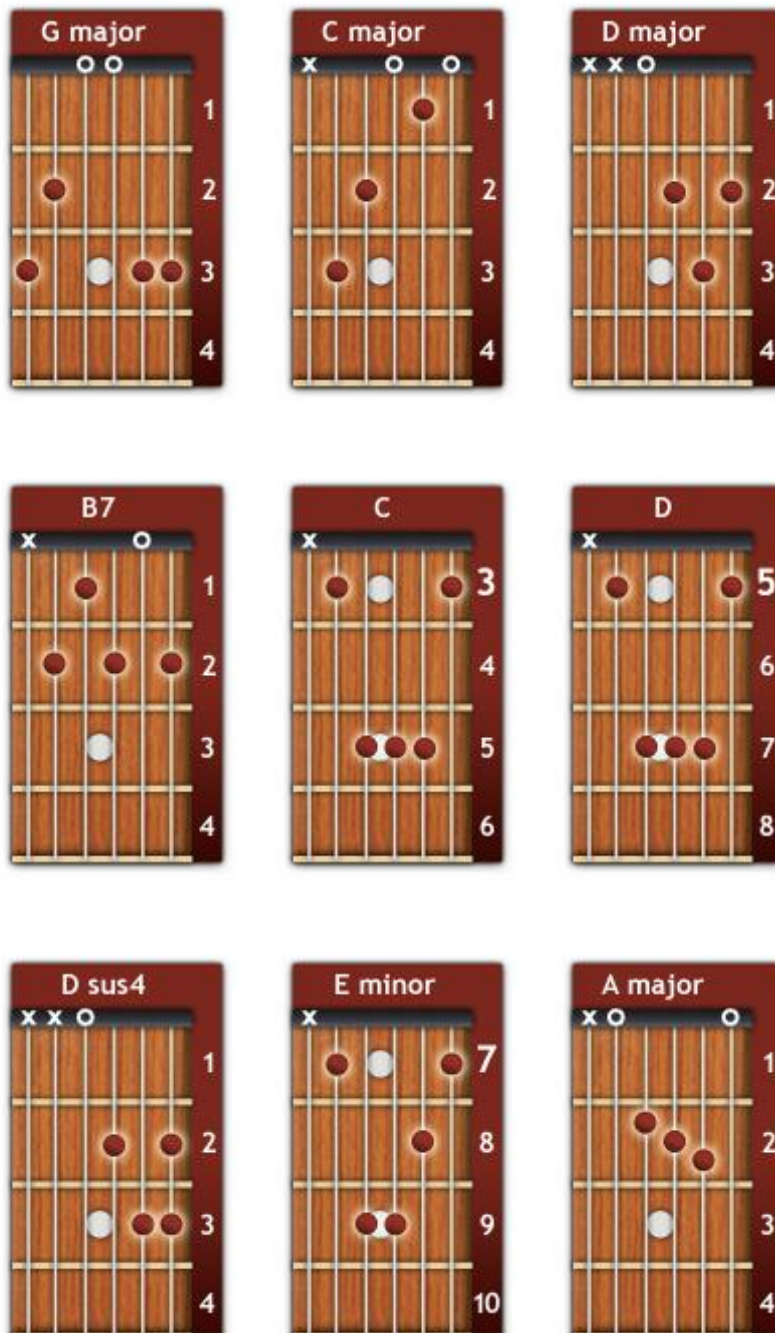


## Nothing Else Matters Guitar Tabs and Chords





### Intro 1





### Intro 2









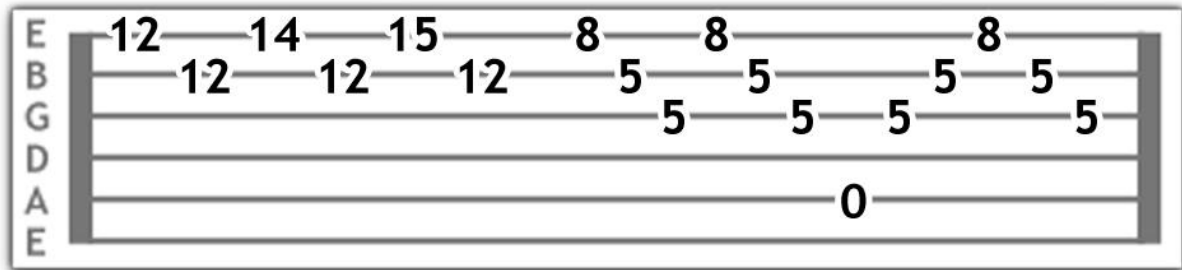

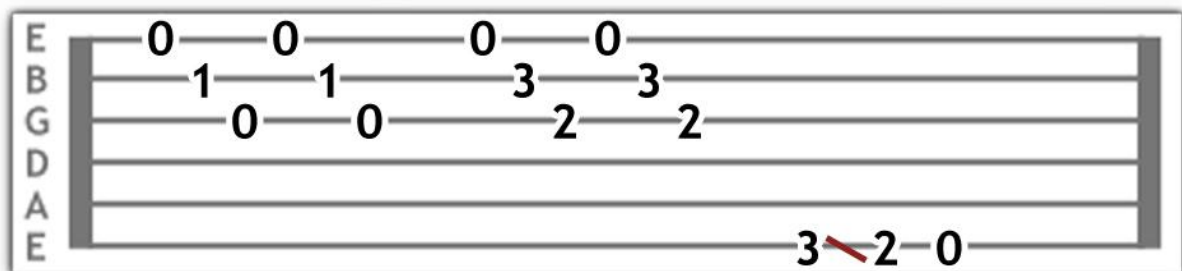
**The order you should be playing the verse sections is:**
