

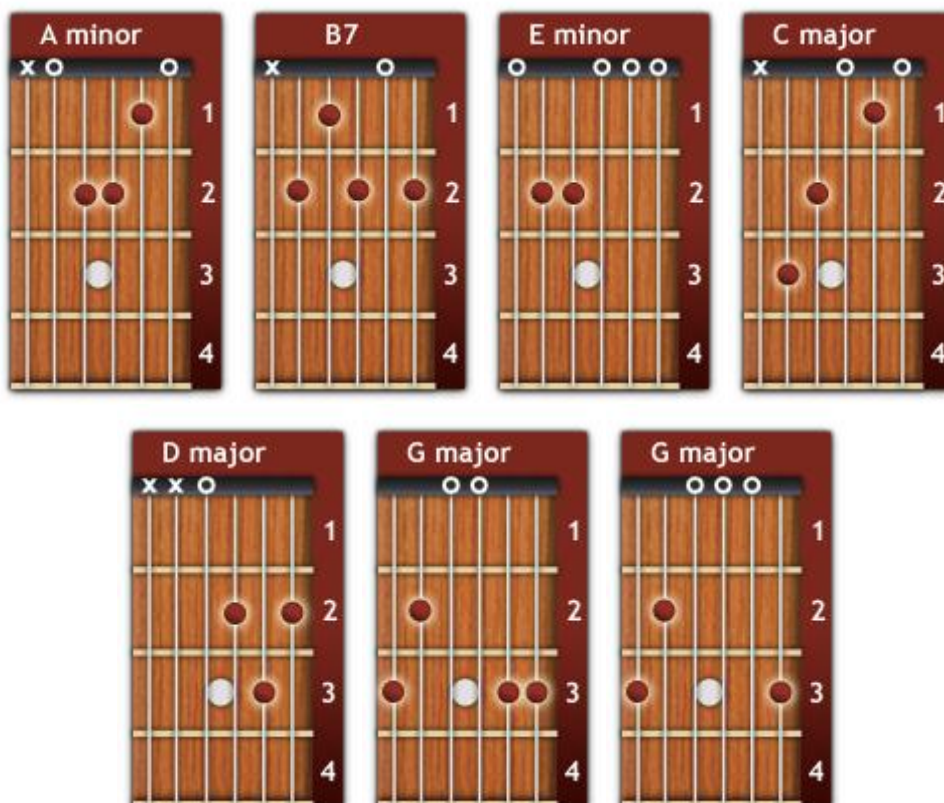
## Greensleeves Guitar Tabs and Chords


### Chords

These are the chords you'll need to know, feel free to use either G major:

















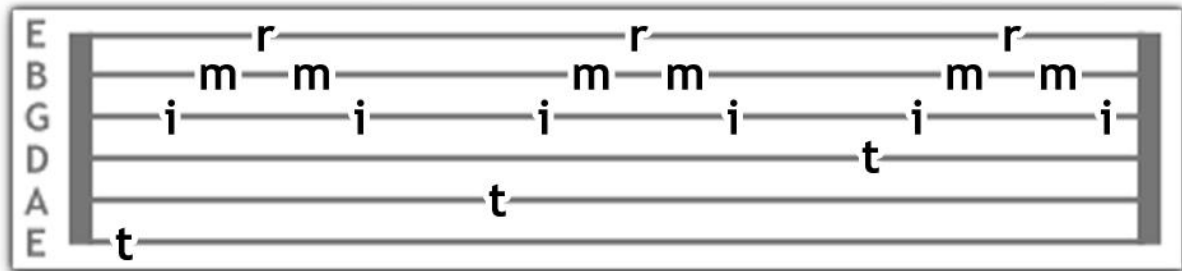

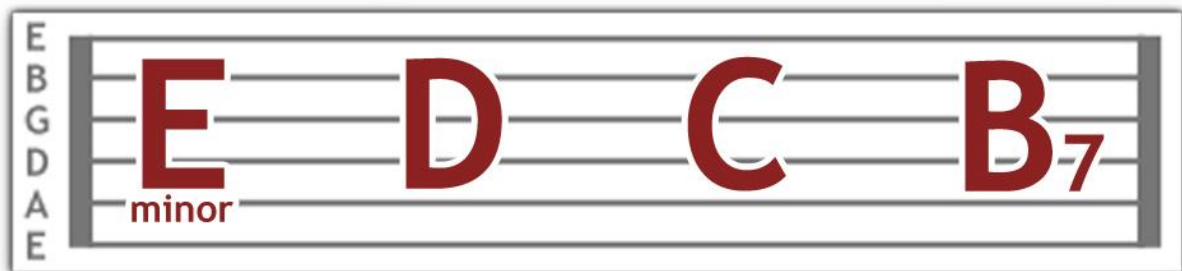
