
Bar Chords

These are the bar chords you'll be playing:




Tabs

Intro 1





Intro 2





Verse 1





The last two strings (D and A) are played with a B minor chord (2, 2) repeated 3 times, followed by an open string (0) on the D string and an open string (0) on the A string.

Verse 2





The last two strings (D and A) are played with a B minor chord (0, 0) repeated 4 times, followed by an open string (0) on the D string and an open string (0) on the A string.

Chorus 1 (See the sequence of chorus tabs after the tabs section)





Chorus 2





Chorus 3





Chorus 4




