

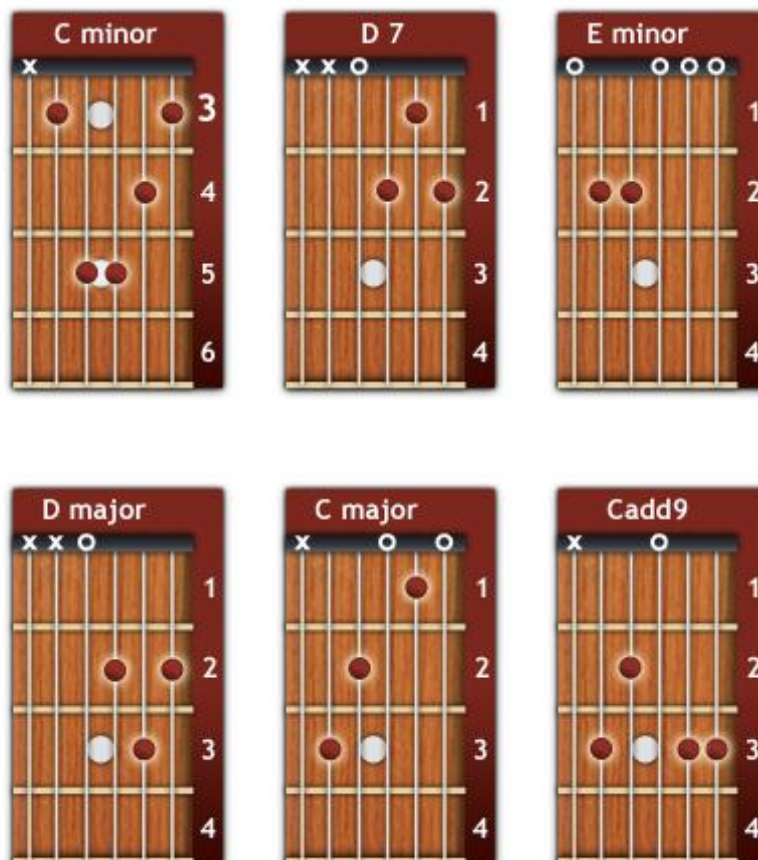
## More Than Words Guitar Tabs and Chords

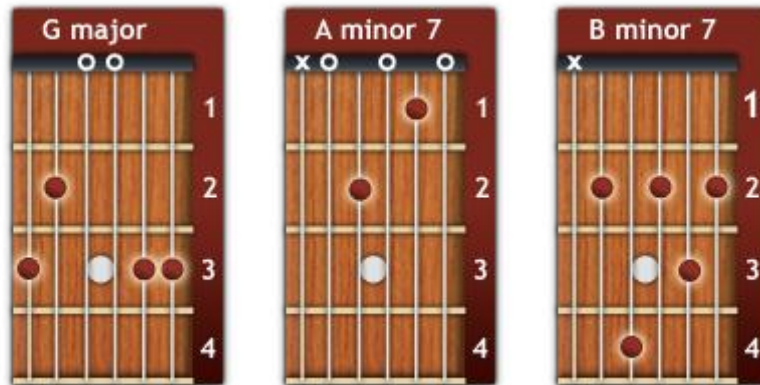

### Chords

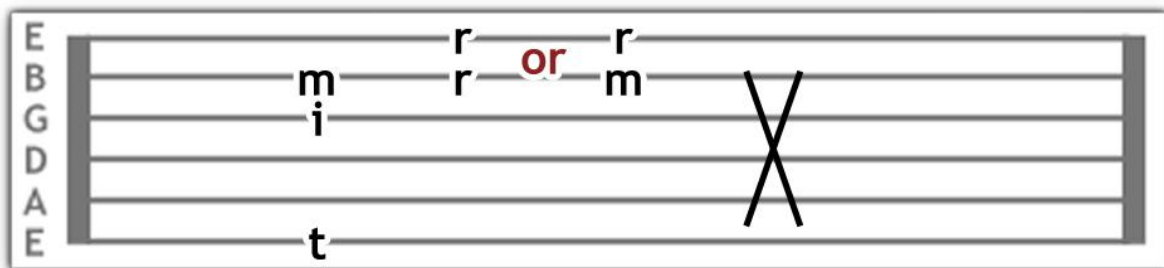

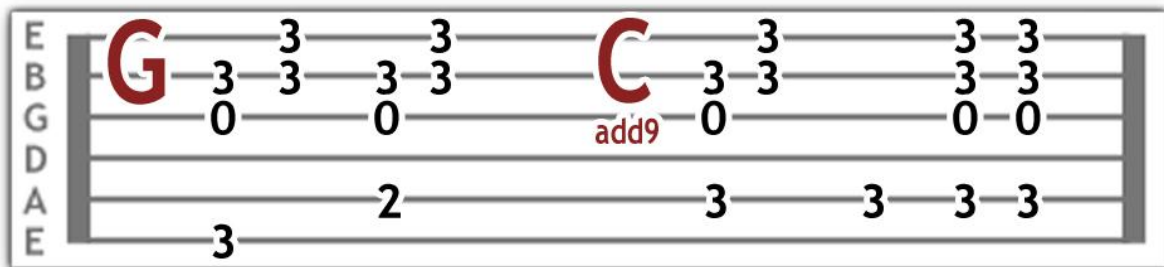

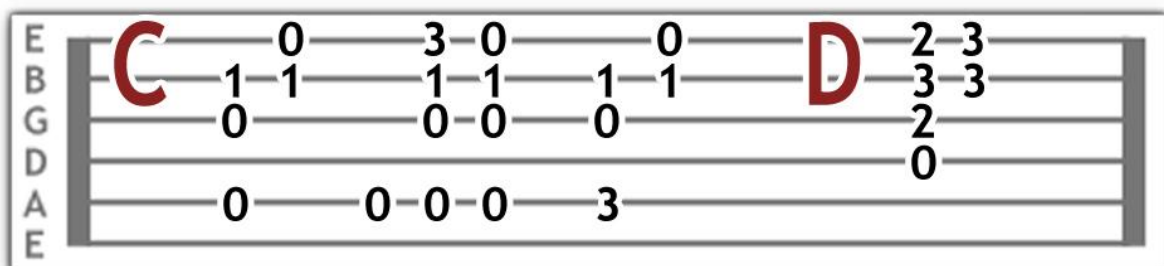
*Basic picking pattern (X means slap the strings to mute them)*






Diagram for Section 2.2 showing guitar fretboard positions for chords D, G, and D/F#.




Diagram for Section 2.3 showing guitar fretboard positions for chords D7 and G7.





Diagram for Section 2.4 showing guitar fretboard positions for chords C and C minor.

**C** chord: E string (0), B string (1), G string (0), D string (0), A string (3), E string (3).


**C minor** chord: E string (3), B string (4), G string (5), D string (3), A string (3), E string (3).










