
Chords

These are the chords you'll be using:





Section 1.a





Section 1.b





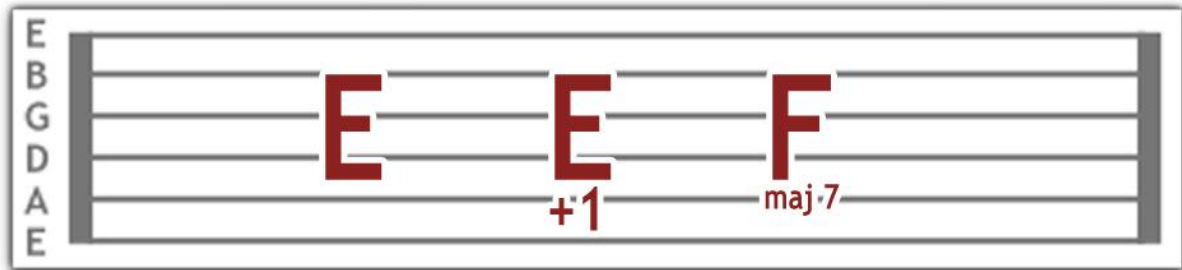

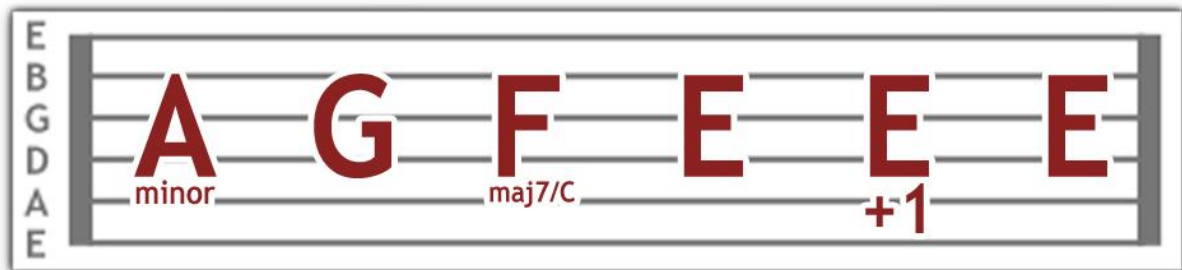

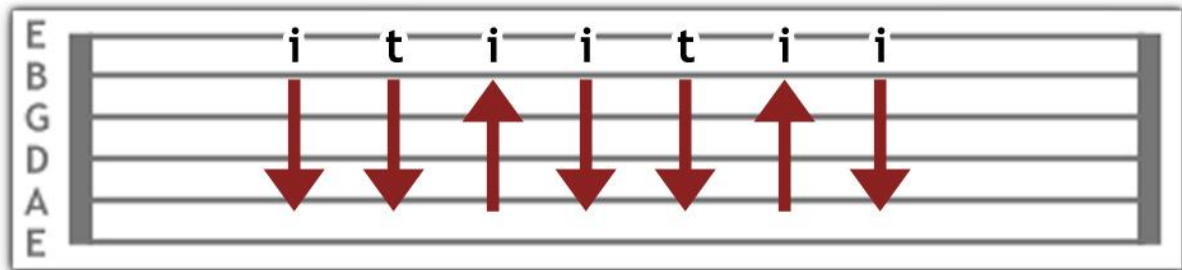
