


## Stairway to Heaven Guitar Tabs and Chords



# Tabs


There are a lot of tabs sequences to learn, so be patient.

## Intro 1





## Intro 2





## Bridge














Diagram showing guitar fretboard positions for chords A minor7 and D. The fretboard is labeled with strings E, B, G, D, A, E from top to bottom.




Diagram showing guitar fretboard positions for chord A minor7. The fretboard is labeled with strings E, B, G, D, A, E from top to bottom.




Diagram showing guitar fretboard positions for a specific scale or sequence of notes. The fretboard is labeled with strings E, B, G, D, A, E from top to bottom.








